

GENERAL BODY MEETING

Meeting of General Body of ISPVT was held at 19.00 hours on 21-12-01 in the conference hall of Veterinary College, GAU, S.K.Nagar. The following issues were discussed and resolved.

Dr. V.V. Ranade welcomed all the members. He appealed all to become life member of the society and contribute positively in raising funds and strengthen hands of Organizing Secretary for holding conference. He suggested that registration fee can be raised or small companies can be contacted for raising funds.

Dr. J.K. Malik thanked all the members for their cooperation in all aspects for smooth functioning of the society and also thanked organizing secretary of the conference for excellent arrangements and also thanked participants for nice presentation of quality research work.

Dr. A.M. Thaker briefed about number of annual / life / students memberships of the society and financial position of the society has revealed.

Dr. A.K. Srivastava appraised all the members about the publication of first issue of our society's journal, Journal of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology

Modification in colour of front page was suggested and after 2 -3 issues it will be finalized.

It was decided to publish two issues per year initially.

Matter has been initiated for registration of the journal with competent authority in Punjab as Dr. A.K. Srivastava told.

Abstracts of the presented paper will be published in next issue of journal.

It was appealed to all to contribute quality research papers for our journal.

Papers will be scrutinized critically and referees are requested to give their frank opinion.

Members of the editorial board have to be life member of the society

A bank account in name of Chief Editor, Journal of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology will be open at Ludhiana and audited report of it should be submitted every year to the society

The following issues pertaining to funding for the journal were discussed—

- 1) For 300 copies of journal of at least 100 pages requires Approx Rs. 40,000 for 1 issue and around Rs 80,000 for two issues.
- 2) Financial assistance from government agency can only be obtained after 2-3 years of publication
- 3) As decided in meeting of executive committee it is appealed to the members that they will please donate either Rs 1000 or 10% of one months of pay for generating funds.
- 4) Advertisements rates as below were proposed

Full page (coloured)	Rs 10,000)
B/W	Rs 5,000
Half page B/W	Rs 2500
- 5) Free copies of journal will be given to life members of the society, advertiser and to libraries of veterinary college for initial 2-3 years and institute where veterinary pharmacology and toxicology are concerned
- 6) Charges of reprinting of research paper

25 reprints	Rs100 per page of paper
50 reprints	Rs150 per page of paper

For subscription fee of journal from commercial institutes, Dr.V.V.Ranade is given responsibility to decide about it.

- 7) For sponsorship of one issue of journal Rs10,000 was proposed
- 8) It was also proposed that for the next three years the head quarter of the journal will be at one place
- 9) It was informed in meeting that Indian Herbs has agreed for a Rs10000 donation for cash price for best research paper on indigenous drugs
- 10) It was also suggested that if any individual wants to initiate any award then Rs 20,000 was proposed as donation amount.

All the proposals were discussed and efforts made by Dr.J.K.Malik for holding conference at Pantnagar was highly appreciated and finally it was resolved that
