

Minutes of the General Body Meeting of ISVPT held on 2.12.10 at 6.00 PM at College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry MPPCVV, Jabalpur – 482 001

1. Confirmation of minutes of GBM of ISVPT held on 6-11-2009 at Veterinary College, Anand.

The minutes of the last General Body Meeting held at College of Veterinary Science and A.H., Anand (Gujrat) were confirmed.

2. To institute ISVPT SK Nagar Best Paper Award

The General House approved the names of Dr. V.V. Ranade (Convener), Dr. Y.P. Sahni (Member) and Dr. A.M. Thaker (Member) to finalize the modalities of instituting the award. Once the modalities were finalized the screening of best paper would be carried out by the same committee for the best paper published from Journal of Veterinary Pharmacology & Toxicology (Official organ of ISVPT) for year 2010 and 2011 and awards shall be presented during the forthcoming meeting of ISVPT.

3. To discuss issues related to institution of FISVPT (Fellow of Indian Society of Veterinary Pharmacology & Toxicology).

Dr. S.K. Garg informed the house that rules FISVPT have been finalized. The house, therefore, resolved that application to this effect shall be received by June 30 each year and process shall be initiated by the Secretary General of the Society and the final decision shall be taken by Executive Council before ensuing Annual meeting of the society.

4. To discuss issues related to financial status of the Journal of the Society

Dr. S.P. Singh, Chief Editor of the journal informed the house that it was becoming difficult to publish Journal from the available resources. To make publication of Journal financially viable, it was suggested to impose reprint charges of the 500/- per article which shall be charged from the authors after the acceptance of the articles. The house also suggested to approach various libraries of the University/ Veterinary Colleges with an Annual Subscription charges Rs. 2000/- per annum comprising two issues. It was also decided to have advertisement from various sources. Additionally, Govt. organizations could be approached for mobilizing financial resources.

5. Presentation of the report by Chief Editor.

Dr. S.P. Singh, Chief Editor of the Journal informed the house that Journal has got NAAS rating and same shall be communicated soon. The Editor also informed the house that all the previous issues of the Journal were available on the internet.

6. Report by the Secretary (Internal Relation)

Dr. A.H. Ahmad Secretary (Internal Relations) informed the house that this year no foreign delegate could be invited for the want of time. He further informed the house that announcements of the Annual conferences often come late and at that time it becomes late to invite any foreign delegate. Keeping this fact in view, the house decided



to initiate the process well in advance and provide free local hospitality to foreign delegates. It was also suggested by a few members to invite delegates from various South Asian and neighboring countries. The houses also suggested of approaching NRIs for membership and encourage them to participate in ISVPT conferences.

7. Report by Treasurer, ISVPT

Dr. S.K. Bhavsar presented before the house the Audited Statement of Accounts and the house approved the same. The house also authorized the treasurer to get the accounts of the year 2010-11 audited from a Chartered Accountant.

8. Issue related to mid term Executive Council Meeting.

The house decided to provide sleeper class fare to and fro fare to all EC members to attend midterm E.C. meeting to be convened at venue site before the commencement of the next Annual meeting.

9. Venue of the next Annual Meeting

The house decided to hold the 11th annual meeting of the Society at Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar (U.P.). Dr. S.K. Mishra was, therefore, requested to obtain the permission of the Director, IVRI for hosting the 11th Annual Conference of the ISVPT at IVRI, Izatnagar (U.P.).
