


## INVITATION

The abstract should include background, objectives, methods, results and conclusions without these headings. Underline the name of presenting author. Please specify the technical

session and mode of presentation i.e. Oral or Poster. Poster size should be 3' (vertical) x 2' (horizontal) including borders. Abstracts should be sent by email on "[isvpt2016@gmail.com](mailto:isvpt2016@gmail.com)". Abstract accompanied with registration fee will only be considered for publication.

## THE VENUE

College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry was established on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2008 under flagship of Navsari Agricultural University, Navsari Gujarat. Navsari city is a district place and one of the oldest cities in Gujarat. Historically, the first settlement of the Parsi community took place in Navsari in 1142 A.D. Apart from being the birth place of eminent personalities like Dadabhai Naoroji and Jamsedji Tata; Navsari has many places to visit like Dandi (salt satyagrah), sandy beach of Umbharat, Vansda National Park and Tithal beach at Valsad. Besides being country's one of the largest exporter of fruits viz. chikoo (Sapota) and mango (Kesar & Alfanso). It is also known for sugarcane, floriculture, diamond, textile, drugs & pharmaceuticals business.

Navsari is on main rail and road line connecting Mumbai and Surat. Navsari is only 40 kilometers south of Surat by road, rail and airport. University campus is just 3 kilometers away from Navsari Railway Station (West). Nearest airports are Surat (40 km away) and Mumbai (250 km away and connected by rail and road to Navsari)

## ACCOMMODATION AND WEATHER

The delegates / guests will be accommodated in University guest houses on payment basis. Accommodation arrangements will be made on prior information/registration and first come first serve basis.
