The abstract should include background, objectives, methods, results and conclusions without these headings. Underline the name of presenting author. Please specify the technical session and mode of presentation i.e. Oral or Poster. Poster size should be 3' (vertical) x 2' (horizontal) including borders. Abstracts should be sent by email on "isvpt2018@gmail.com". **Abstract accompanied with registration fee will only be considered for publication.**

THE VENUE

College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry was established in August 1964 and at present it is constituent college of Anand Agricultural University.
