

Indian Society of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology

“Dr. A.M.Thaker Young Scientist Award for Women”

1. The candidate competing for this prize/medal should have done her research in the frontier areas of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology.
2. The competing candidate should be within 35 years of age. Proof of age should be attached with the abstract/ full length article.
3. There should be at least three contestants for the award.
4. The competing candidate should have a good academic record.
5. The competing candidate should be the first author of her research work presented.
6. The candidate's work should be duly authenticated by her supervisor/head of the institute. The research work should have been carried out in Indian laboratory/laboratories. An undertaking from competent authority should be attached.
7. An authentication certificate signed by all contributing authors should be submitted.
8. The candidate should compete only once with her work done and she should not compete for the next time with the same paper / research work, if she is unsuccessful during the first attempt.
9. The scientist presenting the research work should be the life member of ISVPT. Copy of life membership certificate is to be attached with the application / abstract /paper sent for award.
10. The award is to be given in form of cash and a certificate.
11. The organizing secretary of the ensuing annual conference should constitute a panel of three judges for the selection of best paper.
12. Author(s) should submit clearance letter from IAEC /CPCSEA to conduct the experiment. In case of any legal issues, authors will be solely responsible.
13. The competing candidate will be given eight minutes for presentation and two minutes for discussion.
